



# Institutional Scholarships and Grants

## Merit Scholarship

- Full-time, full-tuition program.
- Returning students will have cumulative GPA and credits earned at the end of Spring 2011 semester to determine award.
- New and transfer students will have higher of incoming cumulative GPA or ACT score to determine award.
- Automatically awarded one half per semester.

## Scholar Dollars

- Up to \$500 per semester match for competitive scholarships from outside sources.
- Minimum 2.00 cumulative GPA required.
- Presentation College endowed or direct scholarships are excluded.
- Automatically awarded once scholarship funds are received.

## PC PASS (Promoting Academic Student Success Program)

- Up to \$500 per semester for students enrolled in the following programs:
  - Social Work, Business, Recreation, and Psychology.
- Full time with 3.00 cumulative GPA.
- Automatically awarded if eligible-new and transfer students only.

## Leadership Grant

- Application required.
- Full-time, full-tuition program.
- Minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA.
- Current student deadline: March 1<sup>st</sup>
- New student deadline: July 1<sup>st</sup>

## Presentation College Grants

- Full-time, full tuition program.
- Demonstrated financial need to assist in funding direct costs for Presentation College.
- Minimum 2.50 cumulative GPA.
- Early FAFSA is recommended as funding is limited.
