1. Completed admission application

2. \$25 application fee *(non-refundable)*
3. Official high school transcripts or official GED scores
4. ACT or SAT scores
5. Official copies of transcripts from other post-secondary schools attended, if any

To be admitted to Presentation College, students must have a minimum grade point average of 2.0 or successful completion of the General Equivalency Diploma (GED) test and a minimum ACT composite score of 18 or minimum SAT composite score of 860.
